



NASCAR Weekly Series Information

- License Breakdown:
 - Feature Division License:
 - Modified Class will be considered Feature Class or “Tier 1.”
 - Feature Division License covers Modified class and all support divisions, will not need separate licenses for more than one division or tier.
 - Cost is \$200 online, or \$225 at the track for paper application.

 - Charger Division License:
 - Tier 2 thru 6 are considered charger divisions
 - Limited Late Model-Tier 2
 - Street Stocks-Tier 3
 - Pure Stocks-Tier 4
 - FWD-Tier 5
 - American Trucks-Tier 6
 - If Class is not listed above then it is not a sanctioned class, and not required to have license. For Example, Destruction classes are not sanctioned so don't require license.

- One License is needed to drive or own in multiple divisions. For example if driving in both Street Stocks an Pure Stocks, only 1 license required.
- Cost is \$100 Online, \$125 at track for paper license.

- Weekly Series Crew License:
 - Cost is \$100 Online, \$125 at track for paper license.

- Weekly Series License per Event:
 - (Feature, Charger, or Crew)
 - Cost is \$25
 - Can be purchased more than once until equals full license amount.
 - Only good for one day.

- Weekly Series 15-Day
 - (Feature, Charger, or Crew)
 - By Request Only
 - Good For 15 Days if planning on visiting the track for a couple races week to week.
 - Can be purchased more than once until equals full license amount.

- National, Regional, and Track Points Championships
 - National Top 100 drivers in each Division receive certificate with national ranking.
 - Regional champions (West, Midwest, Northeast, and Southeast) in each division (tier 2-5) receive Regional Championship Trophy
 - Track:
 - Division 2 \$1,000, \$800, \$500, \$400, \$300, 6th and 7th NASCAR Trophy, 8th-10th NASCAR Plaque
 - Division 3 \$700, \$400, \$350, \$300, \$250, 6th and 7th NASCAR Trophy, 8th-10th NASCAR Plaque
 - Division 4 \$500, \$325, \$250, \$225, \$200, 6th and 7th NASCAR Trophy, 8th-10th NASCAR Plaque
 - Division 5 \$400, \$300, \$225, \$200, \$150, 6th and 7th NASCAR Trophy, 8th-10th NASCAR Plaque
 - Division 6 \$300, \$250, \$200, \$150, \$100, 6th and 7th NASCAR Trophy, 8th-10th NASCAR Plaque
